Find and circle each of your answers in the word search below, then put the unused letters from the word search in order in the spaces at the bottom of the page to spell out a fact about the Exodus.

1. Meaning of "exodus." (9 letters)
2. Central character who was chosen to be the voice and instrument of God. (5 letters)
3. Moses was told to take off his sandals because he was on this. (2 words, 10 letters)
4. English version of the Hebrew name of God revealed to Moses at the burning bush. (6 letters)
5. Brother of Moses, chosen to assist him in delivering God's message. (5 letters)
6. Moses' demand of Pharaoh. (4 words, 13 letters)
7. Disasters visited upon the Egyptians. (7 letters)
8. This is celebrated around a meal including lamb and unleavened bread. (8 letters)
9. God led the people by a pillar of cloud and a pillar of fire to cross this. (2 words, 6 letters)
10. Sister of Moses who sang a song to the Lord. (6 letters)
11. The Israelites gathered this food provided by God. (5 letters)
12. Three months after their departure, the Israelites came to this mount. (5 letters)
