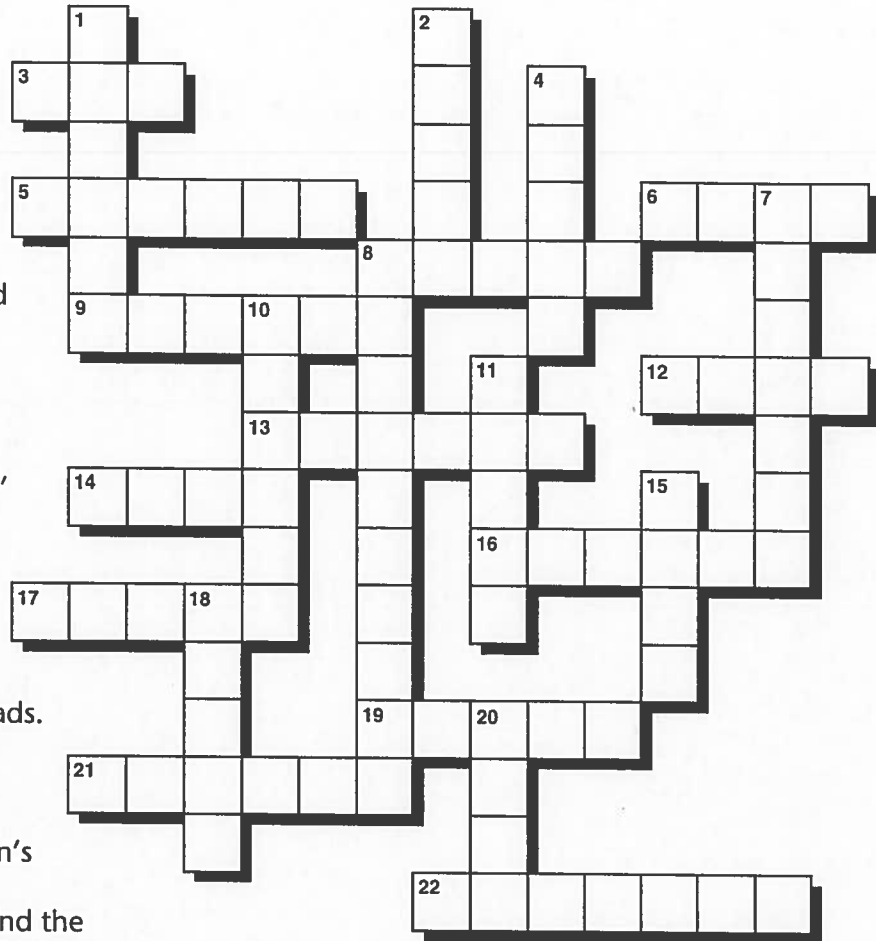


THE REVELATION TO JOHN
